**Johns Manville Fuel Surcharge Increase**

Effective May 15, 2011 Johns Manville will increase the fuel surcharge for all orders from \$175.00 to \$200.00 per truck. This increase affects all trucks shipping from JM manufacturing and warehouse facilities.

As fuel prices have escalated, Johns Manville has continued to absorb these costs for several months without passing on additional assessments to our customers. We can no longer sustain these increases and are therefore forced to pass along the additional fuel surcharge assessments.

Economic forecasts indicate that fuel prices will continue to escalate through the summer months. If these forecasted increases materialize, JM will also implement additional increases. We understand the impact of these increases and are committed to finding efficiencies wherever and whenever possible to serve your commercial roofing transportation needs.
