Re: Price Increase Announcement

The worldwide supply of EPDM polymer is extremely tight and is expected to remain tight through 2011 as the automotive and commercial roofing industries improve. Fortunately, we have received commitments from our suppliers for our forecasted 2011 volumes. However, along with those commitments, we have also received significant cost increases that have already gone into effect. As a result, effective Feb 1, 2011, a 6% price increase will be implemented for EPDM sheeting, flashings, tapes, pipe boots, corners and other EPDM based accessories. Solvent based adhesives, sealants and other accessories will not be impacted.

Re: Price Increase Announcement

Due to rising raw material and transportation costs and some raw material shortages, a 5% price increase will be implemented on all polyisocyanurate products and TPO membranes and accessories, excluding sealants and adhesives, effective March 1, 2011. Existing quotes will be honored however extensions will not be possible. As a reminder, a 6% increase in EPDM pricing will go into effect on February 1.

There currently exists a general shortage of certain raw materials, most notably EPDM polymer and propylene, two of the key components in EPDM and TPO sheeting respectively. News reports suggest that the price of oil is likely to continue to rise. We anticipate that additional increases are likely. To date, adhesives, sealants and PVC have been exempt from these increases but that is unlikely to continue. We will provide as much notice of future increase as possible but please plan accordingly.

The national average diesel fuel rate is \$3.33/ gallon. Our current fuel surcharges are \$25 for shipments less than or equal to 100 miles and \$150 for shipments greater than 100 miles. Should the national average diesel fuel rate increase to \$3.47, both surcharges will increase by \$25.
